What's in a street name?

Omukama Kaboyo - Founder and first ruler of Toro (1820s - c.1860)

Omukama Nyaiika - Toro king killed during Kabarega's invasion in 1876.

Ruhandika - Konzo Chieftain of north Rwenzori who sheltered the infant Kyebambe (Kasagama) from Kabarega of Bunyoro after invasion. Henry Stanley and his expedition were Toro's first European visitors in 1889.

Captain Frederick Lugard - Agent of Imperial British East Africa Co. who helped restore Toro Kingdom in 1891

Omukama Kyebamba (or Kasagama) (1891 - 1929) - Omukama installed with Lugard's help

Omukama Patrick Kaboyo Rukidi III (1966) - Ascended to throne eight months before kingdoms were abolished in 1966.

Bwamba Road leads to the part of Semliki Valley beyond the Rwenzori inhabited by the Bwamba people.

Muguruzi means 'Old Man' in the Rutooro language.
